	Check with local community foundations, banks, and small businesses.
[]	Ask parents' employers if they offer scholarships for employees' children.
[]	Search for niche scholarships related to your major, background, hobbies, or volunteer work.
[]	Use scholarship search tools (Fastweb, Scholarships.com, Cappex) and filter for deadlines
	within 3 months.
[]	Focus on smaller awards (\$500-\$2,000) - less competition.
[]	Keep a rolling scholarship calendar with deadlines and requirements.
[]	Set reminders at least one week before each deadline.
[]	Look for unusual or 'weird' scholarships (duct tape prom, unique hobbies, etc.).
[]	Apply to multiple scholarships each month to increase your chances.
[]	Track awards won and reapply if possible in following years.
